The enigma

- **Keywords**

Recorder, audio player

- **Toolbox**

Jacket - tape recorder - desk with a drawer that could be locked with a key - a small box that could be closed with a locker - locker with a 4 - digit code

- **Description of the enigma**

The players must find a key hidden in the pocket of a jacket. The key opens a desk drawer with a tape recorder inside.

A character involved in the scenario was used to record their memo on a tape recorder. There is only a small sequence in it that the players can listen to. In this message, the players can hear the code the character used for the locker of a box:

'I was thinking about the code 1765 as the birthdate of Sir Wallace but instead I have chosen 5437, composed of my age and my dear brother's'.

The content of the box should contain an object to start another enigma.
