- **Description of the enigma**

Students find pieces of a message cut in the shape of a jigsaw puzzle hidden around the room and assemble them. They will need to read the text to find out a code.

Daniel Defoe was an English writer, born in London in 1660. He is most famous for his novel Robinson Crusoe. It is an adventure story of a man who spent 24 years on an uninhabited island, the story of his struggle to survive, the dramatic encounter with the native Friday, and their eventual escape.

Daniel Defoe lived for 71 years and his most famous novel was published 12 years before his death. When was his novel Robinson Crusoe published?
