## The enigma

- **Keywords**

- **Toolbox**

walkie-talkie, double-sided whiteboard, markers, sheets of paper, fake or real news describing relationships in a group of people.

- **Description of the enigma**

In this scenario, the evil Mastermind has trapped the players. The Mastermind is crazy about a romance TV series. Several elements are required for this experience:

You or a non-player character are in another room with a walkie-talkie;

A sheet with a list of vocabulary to describe relationships has been fixed on a wall;

The players must find a walkie-talkie and a sheet in a desk or a box they unlocked after another enigma. On this sheet has been written:

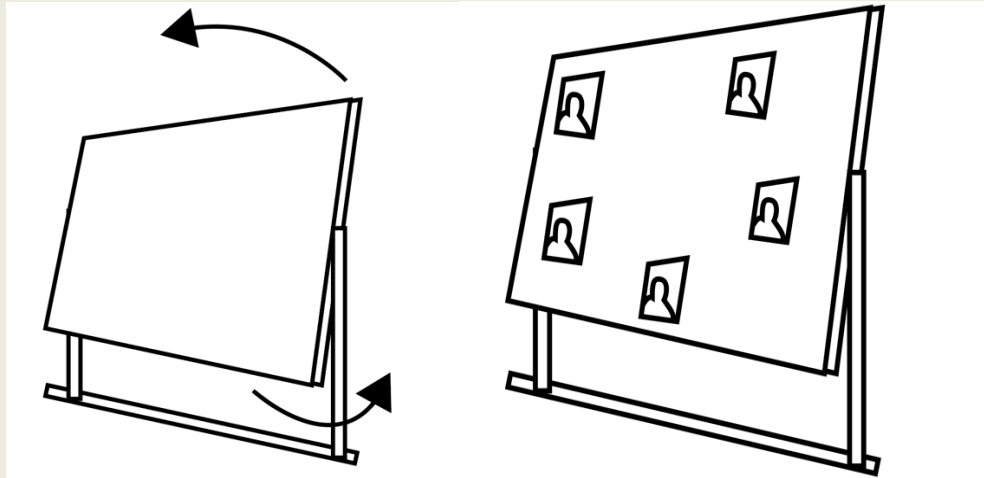
"I love this series... I could have mercy if you prove you know it!"

Along documents, photos, etc., the players must understand the relations between the different characters.



# Relationship vocabulary

A double-sided whiteboard is also in the room. On the reverse side (not visible by the players if they do not manipulate it), they have pictures of the characters dispatched. With markers they will find in the room, then can mark the relations between the characters.



Regularly, players can hear a sound of breath on the walkie-talkie. They must understand that somebody is on the other side.

When you see that the players have started working on this enigma, you can help them by asking them to find the relationships in the order you ask them.

Correct, move to the next one.

Incorrect, stop and don't say anything else. A few minutes later, try again: always restart at the beginning.

If the players finished your list of questions, give them a clue or code to open a vault, to start the next enigma or to open the exit door.

## Possible restrictions

Students with hearing impairments might have trouble to understand parts of your messages. Test your walkie-talkie to be sure that the quality of the sound is good enough. Also, the distance between you and the players could distort the sound: make sure that you are not too far from the game area.
