Worksheet, pencil, laptop, UV marker, UV lamp

- **Description of the enigma**

Students find a laptop with a link to the audio file on conspiracy theories. They are supposed to listen to it to find out the key code. Teachers can use this or any other similar audio documents at B2 level English which will make students improve their listening skills and help them communicate effortlessly. This enigma can work well with any history themed escape rooms.

Around what proportion of the US population believes that the assassination of President John F Kennedy was not the result of a lone gunman? Is it:
a) 6%? b) 16%? Or c) 60%?

Suggested numbers should be written on the wall with UV marker. Students find a UV lamp next to the laptop. After they hear the audio, they will need to use a UV lamp to read the code written on the wall.
