## The enigma

- Keywords

Songs, Conditionals

- Toolbox

Speaker or any device to display videos from the internet

- Description of the enigma

This enigma provides examples of songs with different forms of conditionals and text to fill according to the lyrics. Once the students fill the sentences, they have to count the number of letters which will give them a code.

You can even use all 4 songs and create a longer code with all the answers put together!

Enigma: how many letters in the word that is repeated?

## Zero conditional: ‘Rain’ by The Beatles

They run and hide their heads
They might as well be dead
If the rain $\qquad$ , If the rain $\qquad$
Answer: reads = 5

## Conditionals with songs

First conditional: ‘Bad Guy’ by Billie Eilish

'My mommy likes to sing along with me
But she won't sing this song
If she $\qquad$ all the lyrics
She'll pity the men I know'
Answer: reads = 5

## Second conditional: ‘Grenade’ by Bruno Mars

'Oh, oh, I__ go through all this pain
Take a bullet straight through my brain
Yes, I $\qquad$ die for ya, baby
But you $\qquad$ do the same

Answer: would, would, won't = 14

Third conditional: ‘Should've Said No’ by Taylor Swift
Watch: https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=v9bxXO9fj98 from 1:00
"You should've $\qquad$ that word, about what you did with her, $\qquad$ get back to me"

Answer: known, would = 10

If players find the correct word but not the correct number, tell them to count the number of characters they had to write.

## Possible restrictions

Students with hearing impairments could have trouble to understand part of the lyrics. If the majority of your players have hearing impairments, this enigma could block the experience.

Other usages
Also, you could use this enigma as a reading comprehension where players would have to find the conditional verbs and count the letters.
